Now we have more equipment out at lunchtime the children are then developing their ELLI learning skill of self-agency to take responsibility to tidy up like the bee. 

This term our Real PE focus is to develop our social skills to work with each other respectfully by supporting and encouraging each other.

WE ARE AUTHORS

Across the school from Reception all the way up to Year 6, we have been authors over the past few weeks. In reception, the children have been using their blending and segmenting skills to write words and sentences.

It was very exciting in Year 1 when the children received a postcard from Meerkat Mail, and now they are going to write back. Year 2 have been creating their own aliens from 'Man in on the Moon' and have also written narratives with a dilemma and resolution.

Year 3 authors have been writing suspense stories linked to 'The Ice Palace' and they have also written a diary entry.

Year 4 are learning how to use rhetorical questions, emotive language, and fronted adverbials to persuade their readers to let them take the lead role in a play!

Year 5 have used expanded noun phrases to describe a scene from 'Alex Rider' and Year 6 have written an explanation about why Stanley ended up at Camp Green Lake in 'Holes'.

It's so exciting to see our children using their imaginations and creatively writing about our chosen texts!







CHILDREN LEARNING IN CLASS (CLIC)

It was fantastic to see so many adults join their children to learn as mathematicians in class this week. In Year 1 children were explaining to families the concept of a part whole model using resources and then writing the calculation. In Year 3, 4 and 5 children were rehearsing their times tables using a counting stick. When children know all their timetables, it supports fluency of all other calculations now and in the future.

In term 3, the CLIC will focus on how children use strategies to regulate themselves when they have BIG feelings.






WE ARE DESIGNERS
