SOCIAL DISTANCING AT START AND END OF SCHOOL DAY

The first 2 weeks of 2020-21 academic year have been very exciting! MPA has welcomed staff members, children and young people safely back into school. It has been a joyful couple of weeks!

However, it has been brought to our attention that parents and carers are not following social distancing when bringing and collecting their children to/from the school.

As per DfE guidance, "Schools should consider staggered starts or adjusting start and finish times to keep groups apart as they arrive and leave school...starting and finishing later to avoid rush hour...including that gathering at the school gates and otherwise coming onto the site is not allowed."

Could we kindly ask all parents and carers to follow the staggered start and finish timings and also, when lining up your children to follow 2 metres social distancing, as per markings on the floor.

We plan to keep our class web pages regularly updated and include a page for weekly homework to reduce the amount of paper we use.


