Cost: £2660

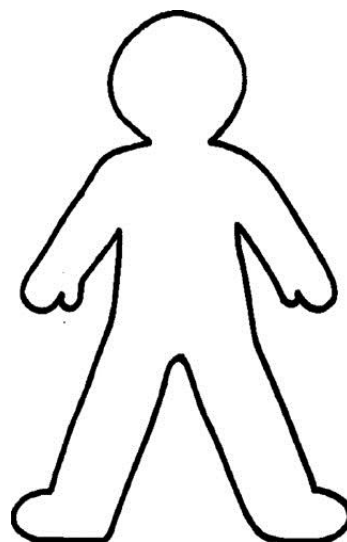
Aim/Outcome: To give all pupils opportunity to participate in various sports
