After School Sports Clubs

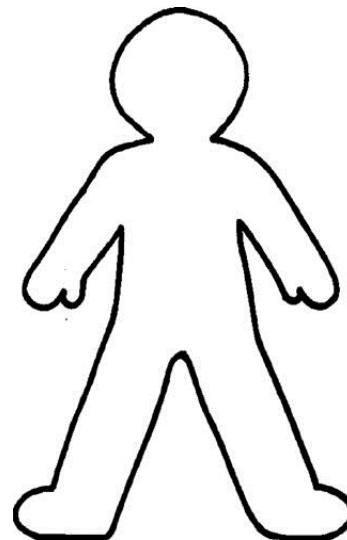
Aim/outcome: To provide long lasting opportunities for pupils to experience a wider range of sporting activities. To develop independence in using a range of equipment.
