Year 6 - Learning outside of the classroom 2023-24

We believe that children benefit from enriching their learning beyond the classroom. This includes free trips and paid for trips. We recognise that with the cost of living we want to make sure that all trips are good value for money and that families have plenty of time to plan for and pay towards these enrichment opportunities.

Below are details of the trips that will take place during this school year and the approximate cost of each trip. Once each trip has been booked, we will write to you again with further details and you will be able to begin to pay.

Year 6 will take part in the following enrichment opportunities throughout the school year:

- **Local walks** around Hillfields, to Hillfields park and to Hillfields library. These local walks will take place regularly throughout the year. These trips are free.
- **Life skills** (Term 1). This trip will cost approximately £16 and will cover entry to the centre, workshops throughout the time there and coach transport.
- **Bristol Brunel Academy Student performance** (Term 2 -> 4th December). This trip is free as the children will walk to and from BBA with school adults.
- **Stone Age workshop** (Term 4). This event will cost approximately £1 per pupil to cover the cost of the virtual workshop.
- Weekly swimming on a Wednesday 9:00 11:00 (Term 5 and 6). There is a cost of £12 for coach transportation for all the swimming lessons.
- Camp (Term 6). This trip will cost approximately £130 to cover the cost of 3 nights away, food for the duration of the stay, centre lead adventurous activities and coach transportation to and from the camp in Dorset.

In addition to the year group specific trips, the whole school will be watching a Panto on Thursday 26th January. This will be part funded by the Friends of Minerva and therefore will cost £2.00 per pupil.

When paying for a trip via scopay, you will be able to tick a box to give permission so no paper slips will need to be returned to school.

Any specific details for individual trips e.g. alterations to school day timings, lunches or school uniform will be emailed in advance.
